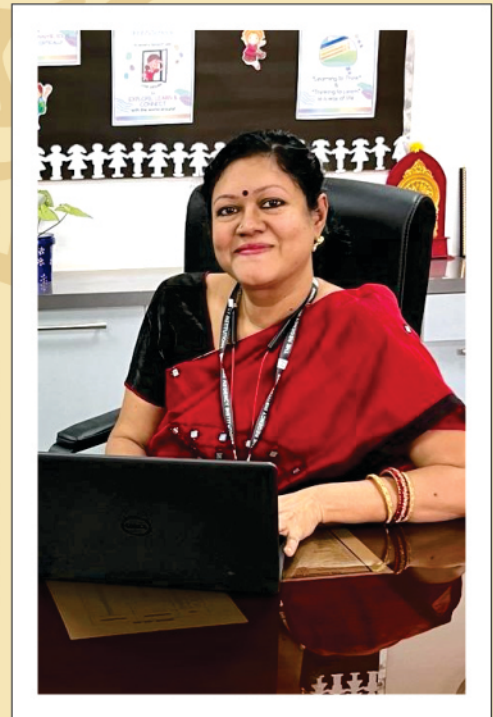
FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK....

Learning is a lifelong process which is stimulated by curiosity. Intelligence and character is the true goal of education.
